

DAY 1 - ATHENS – POROS

The adventure begins. Join us on board as you get to know your home at sea, and fellow travellers, over a welcome drink. Meet our food curator, who will share insights about the culinary experiences planned for the next days. We'll set sail for Poros, arriving just in time for dinner. Relax or enjoy an evening walk, before our overnight journey to Poliegos.

DAY 2 - POLIEGOS – FOLEGANDROS

Wake up in uninhabited Poliegos. The hardest decision you'll make today is whether to jump into the sea, or to enjoy breakfast on deck. We recommend you do both. While our crew prepares our deck BBQ, we'll take the opportunity to learn some history behind local mezedes.

In the afternoon we'll sail to Folegandros to explore the town and Venetian castle. We will choose a hidden family run spot, where our food curator has selected a variety of local bites for you to savor. After completing our walk you are free to explore the amazing Chora and dine ashore. Overnight in Folegandros..



DAY 3 - SANTORINI

Santorini calling. We'll arrive early with plenty of time to explore the capital, Fira, as well as the smaller village of Oia with its blue-domed views over the caldera. This is the place to get those Instagram shots. Optional tour of the archaeological site, Akrotiri. Our food specialist will brief you on all secrets of Santorini wines and delicacies. As evening falls, enjoy the world-famous Santorini sunset with sundowners on deck. Overnight in Santorini.

DAY 4 - ANTIPAROS – PAROS

Overnight in Mykonos - in case you don't want to leave the party early!



DAY 6 - SYROS

Wake up and refresh with a morning dip in the sea then all aboard for the trip to Syros, the capital of the Cyclades. Here you can relax, rest, and rejuvenate on the beach, or you can take part in our optional tour and explore the town and its unique architecture. Join our curated walk, taste Syros products while listening to the captivating island stories. Overnight in Syros.



DAY 7 - KYTHNOS – CAPE SOUNION – ATHENS

We begin our journey back to Athens, with a last opportunity to jump into the inviting sea at Kolones Bay, Kythnos. Dry off as we sail towards Cape Sounion to view the Temple of Poseidon from the sundeck. On arrival back at Marina Zea, enjoy a Captain's Farewell Dinner before bedding down for one more night on board.



DAY 8 - ATHENS

Disembarkation at 8:30 - 9am after breakfast.

Children 11-17 years old: 35% discount on the gross per person twin cabin fares

In all other cabin arrangements, adult rates apply..

- SINGLE parent with 1 or max 2 children in same cabin: The parent pays Single cruise fare & children cruise for FREE

PAYMENT

25% deposit is required 7 days from confirmation.





CABIN SPECIFICATIONS

The Galileo's 24 outside guest cabins are located on Upper and Lower Decks, all with large portholes. Elegantly decorated, they have either twin or double sized beds and bathrooms with showers en suite. Category B cabins have flexible bedding arrangement. All cabins are comfortably arranged and beautifully furnished with wooden furniture and light fabrics. Cabins have individually controlled A/C, offer storage space, and are fitted with flat-screen TVs, mini fridge, telephone (for internal use), hairdryers, central music, public address system and safe boxes.

LIFE ON BOARD

During the day, life on board centers around the indoor lounge area and dining room, as well as the outdoor areas at the Main, Upper and Sun decks. The Captain will drop anchor at secluded bays and beautiful uninhabited islands where, weather permitting, guests enjoy swimming, snorkeling, kayaking.

Main deck lounge & dining room

Renovated in 2020, the main deck lounge area with an American bar leads into a warm and elegant dining room finished with wood and carpet flooring, and beautiful soft fabrics. The spacious dining room seats all passengers in a single, unassigned seating and allows for spectacular views around you, while dining in an elegant environment. Food is served at the table or displayed on the state of the art hot & cold buffet which also includes an "a la minute cooking" section.
